Lecturer position in communication, to begin August 2008. The person in this position will teach four courses per semester in the applied communication program that could be some sections of the following: communication theory, communication research, business and professional communication, critical discourse, and other core courses in speech communication as appropriate.

Qualifications: The candidate should also have student centered teaching experience, professional experience and collegiality suitable to a department with the reputation of giving personal attention to students. Doctorate preferred, ABD status is the minimum requirement. Candidates who are committed to creating a more diverse environment are particularly encouraged to apply.
